

MinibikeMasters Needs You!

Round 1 of the Minibike Masters has been and gone and we want to say a massive thank you to everyone who supported us from the marshals to the lap scorers, our sponsors and of course all the riders. It was especially great to see so many kids, youths and novices and even the over 40's out on track – our number 1 priority is to provide first class racing to all, regardless of age or experience.

The first round was a steep learning curve for us and we are very grateful for all of the feedback and positive comments that we've had. There are a few things that we've learnt from round 1 and we've already identified a few things that we need to improve to make your race day even better. This is where you guys can help...

1. Marshals – It's no secret that we struggled to find enough marshals on the day and so we would really love to hear from anyone who can help here – even a couple of hours would be great. We are trying to avoid the common motocross approach, whereby riders are required to provide a marshal or pay an additional fee to cover the cost of paid marshals. The unfortunate reality however is that if we are unable to find enough volunteers to marshal at our races, we will have no choice but to revert to the compulsory marshal/fee rule. 2. Numbers and backgrounds – We are running a lot of classes in order to try to cater for all ages and abilities and this means that we have to run some mixed class races in order to get through the race schedule and provide everyone with a good amount of track time. At round 1 there were a good few riders with the wrong colour numbers or backgrounds, which makes the already challenging task of lap scoring even more difficult where we have two classes in the same race. We will honour the results for those with the wrong colour combinations for round 1, however from round 2 onwards any rider with the wrong colour numbers or backgrounds will not be lap scored or credited with a position. 3. Litter – Please either use the bins provided or take your litter home with you. For round 2 we will have bin bags available at signing on, please let us know if you would like one – they are free ;-)
